Snack Stand Duties

Pre-game Duties

- Arrive 1/2 hour before the game to setup
 1. Start grills (main and Weber warmer grill)
 2. Check cash box (should be \$60.00 small bills & \$10.00 in quarters. Don't count small change.
 3. Wash hands.
 4. Prepare condiments (lettuce, tomatoes, onions, relish, pickles, ketchup, mustard, etc. and set out by game time. Place condiments in ice filled containers
 5. Sign in.

Game Duties

- Need three persons (2 on counter and one for the grill).
- No children are allowed in the snack stand.
- Try to anticipate food order rushes. Having a few hotdogs and burgers already cooked will speed the orders (we keep the cooked burgers and hot dogs in pans of hot water on the low heat Weber grill). Keep the grills on until the end of the game.
- Burgers can be grilled frozen. Hot dogs thawed first.
- Hot links and chicken breasts are kept frozen until use then microwave 1 min. and placed on the grill to finish.
- Split the pot
 1. Sell tickets beginning in the 3rd inning. Prices on bucket.

Game Duties cont.

2. Count the proceeds when split pot is done and divide the proceeds by two. Put leagues half in envelope and indicate amount.
 3. Put winners half in baggie. Have someone draw winning ticket and then take ticket and money to announcers booth.
- Try to get after game orders before end of game. Have it announce by 5th inning.
 - Team order specials. See bulletin board in snackstand.
 - Keep refrigerator and freezer doors tightly closed.
 - Refrigerators and freezers are marked as to contents. Other non-refrigerated food and supplies are in the back room or under the counter.
 - If we run short or out of items, please write them on the clip board.

After game shut down

- Umpires offered complimentary meal, soda, water.
- Pay umpire out of snack stand monies. See sheet for specific amounts. Write amount paid on the snack stand revenue envelope.
- Shut down grill and turn off the gas. Scrape the grill.
- Refrigerate the condiments. Discard old tomatoes and lettuce.
- Count the money (don't count the coins). Leave \$60.00 in small bills(1's, 5's, & 10's) in the top drawer and count the rest of the bills. Put the bills in the envelope. Date and time the envelope. Leave in secured container in the snack stand
- Empty snack stand trash cans, sweep the floor, wipe counters and wash all utensils.
- Restock items as needed. Especially the drinks refig.
- Close door and turn of lights.
